

Inhabiting future frictions. Confronting climate collapse

This cycle of seminars discusses the role of architecture in questioning the challenge posed by the Capitalocene reflecting on climate urbanism and justice. Thinking critically through feminist and post-colonial approaches, political ecology, design theory and practice the talks elaborate on the creative potential of architecture.

The seminars have been organised as part of the course Architecture, Society and Territory (B) in the MSc in Architecture for Sustainability. The design studio aims to provoke a critical architectural reading of the paradigms of sustainability in global contested territories interrogating the supporting network of life that enables the inhabitation of the inhabitable and allows for imperfect and multiple forms of life to exist.
